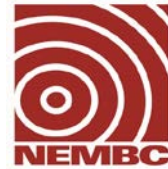


NEMBC 2017 Youth Media Conference Travel Subsidy Application Form



The NEMBC will be offering financial assistance for broadcasters travelling to Canberra from interstate or rural/regional New South Wales for the purposes of the conference.

This subsidy gives applicants travel support to cover the total cost (GST inclusive) of a budget return ticket.

This subsidy offer is limited. To be considered, applicants must:

- Complete and submit this form before Wednesday, 25 October 2017
- Live outside of Canberra i.e. from a regional/ rural area or interstate
- Broadcast a program on community radio or has done in the last year
- Notify your station manager before applying
- Agree to the Terms and Conditions outlined at the end of this document

Applications for a travel subsidy to the NEMBC 2017 Media Conference close Wednesday, 25 October 2016.

Please note: this subsidy will cover 50 per cent to 80 per cent (GST inclusive) of a return budget airfare to Canberra for the purpose of the 2017 Radioactive Youth Media Conference. Exceptional cases will receive a 81 per cent to 100 per cent (GST inclusive) subsidy in exceptional cases.

Youth conference travel subsidies are allocated on a priority basis.

This subsidy covers travel costs only. The applicant is responsible for booking and paying for their own accommodation. Ask your station for assistance.

1. Travel is for the purposes of the 2017 Radioactive Youth Media Conference.
2. This subsidy is only provided for one budget return ticket or petrol receipt from applicant's point of origin to Canberra.
3. If you do not attend the 2017 Radioactive Youth Media Conference your subsidy agreement may be revoked and/ or monies expended on your behalf will have to be reimbursed to the NEMBC.
4. Applicants are responsible for booking and paying for a budget return ticket and proof of purchase must be forwarded to the NEMBC.
5. Applicants must purchase and pay for a budget return ticket and will be reimbursed the nominated percentage (GST inclusive) of the ticket purchased. This nominated percentage will be agreed upon by the NEMBC and applicant prior to booking travel passage.
6. Proof of purchase shall be in the form of a tax invoice which the applicant must provide to the NEMBC in order to receive a subsidy payment and free registration. Failure to produce a tax invoice or proof of purchase will render the subsidy agreement and free registration invalid.
7. Reimbursement cost will be forwarded approximately two weeks after the last day of the Conference.
8. Car travel reimbursements will be provided in the form of payment for kilometres travelled to and from the conference as calculated by the most direct route through RACV travel map distances as determined by the NEMBC. Reimbursement is non-negotiable and is to be agreed upon prior to travel taking place.
9. Hire car/ or Taxi costs shall not be covered by NEMBC under any circumstances.
10. If you are an applicant under the age of eighteen as at the 24 November 2017, authorisation for your attendance must be presented in writing to the NEMBC duly signed and dated by a parent or guardian.
11. You must notify your station manager if you are applying for a travel subsidy.
12. The NEMBC shall not be responsible for travel cancellation or failure of booked transit services either by the applicant's personal action and/ or inaction, industrial dispute, schedule and/ or technical difficulties, "force majeure" or any other issue(s) that prevents the applicant from attending the conference. There shall be strictly no refunds to the benefit of the applicant.
13. The NEMBC reserve all rights to reject the application without entering into dialogue or correspondence with the applicant.
14. Applicants will need to arrange and pay for their own accommodation.
